ORDER

BSB GROUP OF INDUSTRIES has applied for Permission/ NOC for All Types of Sport with the following details.

NOC has been given on the following condition:

1. The organizer will start their programme from _____ and finish by _____ Strictly.
2. The organiser shall STRICTLY restrict the maximum numbers of Bike/Scooters/2 Wheelers to only.
3. Medical facility should be arranged with Doctors and Paramedical staff, Medicine etc. by the organizer.
4. The date, time and route stated above shall be strictly adhered to.
5. The participants (not more than one row) shall proceed continuously at a reasonable pace from its starting point to ending point.
6. The Participants of the programme must wear helmet and shoe and obey all traffic laws, rules and regulations.
7. The programme will move in such a manner as not to interfere with the ordinary use of the street or roads by the public. It will keep to the left hand side of the road and cease playing music and making other loud noise when passing hospitals/schools etc
8. Organiser shall stick to the route as approved above.
9. The programme should take only one lane of the road and follow all the safety rules while riding.
10. There should not be any assault, criminal force, threat of any type or any other obstructions to the on duty Govt. servant from discharging their lawful duty during the said programme.
11. The article 19 (1) (b) of the constitution of India i.e "Assembly, peaceably & without arms" should be strictly adhered to.
12. The organizer shall obey the traffic rule and shall not cause any danger, obstruction or any inconvenience to the other road users and hindrance to normal traffic flow at the nearby road during their programme.
13. The Organiser should ensure that there should not be any obstruction of free movement of the vehicles of emergency services on the said route during the rally.
14. There should not be any speech/visible representation of any symbol etc. which may disturb communal and social harmony, law & order and general peace in the society.
15. The applicant and organizers will be responsible for the conduct of the participants or any other unlawful activities committed by them.

16. Arrangement for Ambulance should be kept by the organiser during the rally.
17. In case of indulgence in any unlawful activities or violation of the conditions of permission, the permission may be withdrawn at any moment without assigning any reason thereof and any such violation will liable for prosecution as per provision of law.
18. The permission accorded by this order shall always be subject to the maintenance of Law and Order and if any law and order problem is apprehended as per the report of the local Police, the permission so accorded hereby shall be withdrawn forthwith in the
19. 19. The applicant/organiser should give an undertaking as per Supreme Court of India guidelines to this office that they will comply with all the terms and conditions.
20. In case of public complaint of inconvenience due to the conduct of the programme, the permission may be withdrawn after verification of the complaint by local police.
21. The organizer should organize their weightlifting championship within the above mentioned venue only.
22. The organizer should obtain NOC from the concerned authority of the venue.
23. They shall not block any public thoroughfare or public road during the programme.
24. Pandal and other construction should be made with fire retarded materials.
25. The organizer is directed to contact with local Police while constructing the pandal etc. at the venue.
26. They will ensure of orderliness in the programme and to take adequate measures to maintain peace and tranquility.
27. Organizer shall detail adequate number of volunteers / private security for maintenance of the parking/ entry gate/ seating areas to ensure orderliness in the programme.
28. Organizer shall ensure that vehicles used by the participants, visitors who come to the programme should be parked in a manner so that they do not create any hindrance to the smooth flow of traffic.
29. The participant should follow all the rules and regulation for maintaining peacefully conducts of the programme.
30. The organizer shall keep uninterrupted power supply and provision of Generator at the venue.
31. Use/ Sale of any types of alcohol/ intoxicating/ narcotic/ psychotropic substance in any form during the programme are strictly prohibited.
32. The permission accorded by the order shall always be subject to the maintenance of Law & Order and if any Law & Order problem is apprehended as per the report of the local Police, the permission so accorded hereby shall be withdrawn forthwith in
33. The organizer is directed to contact with local Police for smooth conduct of the programme.
34. In case of public complaint of inconvenience due to the conduct of the programme, the permission may be withdrawn after verification of the complaint by local police.
35. The organiser shall STRICTLY restrict the maximum numbers of Cars _____ (_____) Nos only.
36. This order is valid under the jurisdiction of Police Commissionerate only.
37. The Participants of the programme must wear seat belt and shoe and obey all traffic laws, rules and regulations.
38. The Use of loudspeaker will be in low volume (within 90 dB) without disturbing general public.
39. Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Police authority specifically regarding decibel level of loudspeakers and use of firecrackers etc. shall be strictly complied.

40. The Organizer is directed to obtain No objection Certificate from the local APDCL/ Fire and Emergency Service Assam.
41. The Organizer shall not violate any law of land.
42. The organizer shall ensure that the participants of the programme shall not break law while coming to attend the programme as well as during the returning time after the programme.
43. They shall take adequate precautions against the fire hazards and sufficient fire fighting equipments should be made available at the programme site.
44. Any type of Rain Dance/Tomato Dance/ obscenity are not allowed.
45. Eve teasing and other anti-social vices are to be refrained from.
46. Organiser are required to maintain decorum and decency during the programme. In case of any nuisance organizers will be held responsible.
47. All programmes/ performance shall be within the socially acceptable, have ethical and cultural values.
48. Pandals/Stage and other construction near Road side are not allowed STRICTLY.
49. The Organizer must obtain "No Objection Certificate" from Concerned Company while playing Pre-recorded music in the form of Gramophone Records, Music cassettes or CDs etc as applicable.
50. The Local Police concerned should be informed at 24 hours prior to the conduct of the aerial survey in their respective jurisdiction.
51. The firm must follow, all the guidelines of para 13 of civil Aviation requirements (CAR) on civil drones which states that no drone shall be flown:-
52. With a distance of 3 Km from the perimeter of any civil, private or defence airports.
53. With 3 Km from perimeter of military installations/facilities where military activities/ exercises are being carried out unless clearance is obtaining from the local military installation/facility.
54. With 2 Km of perimeter of strategic location/vital installations notified/declared by Ministry of Home Affairs, unless clearance is obtain from MHA.
55. With 3 Km radius of State Secretariat Complex.
56. "Green Zone" means the airspace from the ground up to a vertical distance of 400 feet (120 metre) above ground level (AGL).
57. Fly only during daylight (after sunrise to before sunset), good weather and in visual line of sight (VLOS).
58. Don't drop or carry hazardous material.
59. Don't fly drone under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
60. Don't fly drone from a moving vehicle, ship or aircraft.
61. Only Nano (Less than or equal to 250 grms.) category are allowed to fly without UIN and UAOP.
62. Micro (Greater than 250 grms and less than or equal to 2 KG) category are permitted with production of UIN and UAOP.
63. Fly upto a height of 50 ft. (15 metre) in case of Nano RPAS and 200 ft. (60 metre) in case of Micro RPAS. Beyond this height the Drones are not permitted.

64. The organizer must follow the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India while using sound systems, loud speaker and bursting Fire Crackers .
65. The noise level at the boundary of the public place, where loudspeaker or public address system or any other noise source is being used shall not exceed 10 dB(A) above the ambient noise standards for the area or 75 dB(A) whichever is lower.
66. No one shall beat a drum or tom-tom or blow a trumpet or beat or sound any instrument or use any sound amplifier at night (between 10. 00 p.m. and 6.a.m.) except in public emergencies.
67. The peripheral noise level of privately owned sound system shall not exceed by more than 5 dB(A) than the ambient air quality standard specified for the area in which it is used, at the boundary of the private place.
68. There shall be a complete ban on bursting sound emitting firecrackers between 10 pm and 6 am. However, this restriction is not applicable on bursting of colour/light emitting firecrackers.
69. Install sufficient number of CCTV cameras in around Programme Premises in consultation with local Police Station.
70. There should not be selling, hiring, distribution, exhibition, circulation of any obscene object or perform any obscene act, utter any obscene songs, ballad or words during the programme.
71. Any type of Gambling/ dice/ lottery selling is strictly prohibited.
72. The number of participants should be restricted in order to cause minimum inconvenience to general public.
73. Only fully vaccinated person are allowed.
74. The organizer must ensure proper use of sanitizer.
75. The spectators/organizer must ensure proper wearing of mask during the Programme.
76. Players will have to wear masks except during the time of play.
77. The spectators/organizer must ensure social distancing during the Programme.
78. Organizer will be earmarked parking area for the invitees, guest, press & media personnel and ensure proper guarding by deploying private security.
79. Pandals and other construction of this programme should be made with fire retarded materials.
80. Any Type of Procession is not allowed.
81. They are not allowed to come out from the venue during the meeting.
82. They shall not sit on the road and roadside or block the normal traffic flow of the road in any circumstances.
83. The Organizers should not be undertaking any procession before and after the completion of the programme.
84. The Organizer to ensure free flow of traffic by engaging volunteers addition to Traffic police in the programme.
85. The police will be compelled to stop the use of loudspeaker/music if the organizer fails to do so.
86. Organizer are required to maintain decorum and decency during the programme. In case of any nuisance organizers will be held responsible.
87. No Trailors or Heavy Vehicles are allowed during the Procession.
88. Religious programme to be held in such a manner without causing disturbance to the neighborhood or people residing in the vicinity.

89. Organizer must clean the programme site/ premises/ filed by - Date:_____ (preferably just after completion the theatre show).

90. They shall adequate precautions on case of electrically fittings and wirings etc. to avoid any incident of short circuiting and fire hazard.I
